 Driving to Cairns from Innisfail on Bruce Hway, turn left at Palmerston Hway turnoff (4 km). Drive approx. 30 kms to Wooroonooran NP. Vantage points, Crawford's Lookout & Mamu Tropical Skywalk, give spectacular views of the Johnstone River Gorge. There are many picnic and swimming spots such as . Henrietta & Goolagan's Creek & self-guided walks. Go back towards Innisfail, take South Johnstone turnoff on right and take a scenic drive along Henderson Drive to Wangan then Paronella Park. • Driving north to Cairns turn off & drive 8 km to Josephine Falls carpark. This is the starting point for Broken Nose & the Summit treks (see Walking Track maps over), 10 min, walk through beautiful rainforest to Falls. Returning, turn right. Take picnic lunch to have beside deep waterhole of The Golden Hole Recreational Area.

kayak. • Coconut-fringed Bramston Beach is just 13 km from the highway (turnoff before Miriwinni). Have lunch or swim. Returning (6 km), take turnoff to Eubenangee Swamp N.P. • Follow walking track to Lookout (remember insect repellent). After walk, continue south past historic Garradunga Hotel. Follow Old Bruce Hwy and signs around to left to Flying Fish Point/Innisfail (alternate route). Continue to the Coconuts - turn right to view the picturesque mouth of the river). Continue to panoramic **Lookout**, have a relaxing meal at a **beachside cafe**. Campers and fishermen continue to the Flying Fish Point Tourist Park and secluded Ella Bay N.P.

# COOUETTE PT - AUST SUGAR HERITAGE CENTR

From Innisfail, drive south on Bruce H'way (1 km) and turn right to Townsville. Continue until Mourilyan (8 km). Stop at the Heritage Centre and experience the drama and heritage of the Sugar industry. • Take next left turn to charming Etty Bay, follow sign left (13 km). Look out for cassowaries as you

drive over the top of the range but don't miss the breathtaking ocean view. Swim & enjoy lunch. Driving back, take turn on left & go to Mourilyan Sugar Terminal (7 km) and Mourilyan Harbour and boat ramp. Don't forget insect repellent when fishing & crabbing.

Visit the coral beaches of Barnard Islands (N.P. permits required) or Olive Rock for great fishing.

 Returning, turn right off highway at sign to East Innisfail. Continue to roundabout at the new Jubilee Bridge, turn right along the Corso out to Violets & Lace Nursery for

spectacular views. Watch for cassowaries. Return to Innisfail.

# PARONELLA PARK - CANECUTTER WAY

INNISFAIL

From Innisfail, drive south on Bruce H'way (1 km) and at Townsville turn off, drive straight ahead along the Canecutter Way (Old Bruce H'way).

Drive and enjoy the wonderful scenery, country pubs and towns - to Wangan, South Johnstone (8 km), Mena Creek and Paronella Park (17 km), a must see destination needing to be seen to be believed (allow 2 hrs). Historic buildings, guided tours, rainforest walks, tropical gardens & picnic area.

• Drive on to Silkwood, home of Australia's smallest National Bank, and on to Kurrimine Beach, a quiet village renowned for fishing and boating. King Reef is just 100 metres off shore and you can even walk to the reef at low, low tide.

• Returning to Innisfail via Bruce Hway, turn right to **Cowley Beach**- where there is access to a boat ramp. View or visit the uninhabited Barnard Islands. (National Park permits required). Take a picnic lunch and walk south along the beach to the mouth of Liverpool Ck for a spot of fishing.

Tropics World Heritage Area, Wooroonooran boasts some of the oldest surviving rainforest in the world. Walking tracks include:

•Crawford's Lookout to North Johnstone River

Lookout (1.5kms) - the track winds down, dropping some 500m. There is access to river via a steep 800m walk from junction. Crawford's Lookout along Highway to the entrance to Tchupala Falls (2kms).

•From here the track leads either to Tchupala Falls or to spectacular Wallicher Falls •Continue to Goolagan's Ck Picnic Area (3kms)

track (800m) then follows Henrietta Creek and links the picnic and camping areas.
•From here, the track climbs the ridge that separates Henrietta and Douglas Creeks. It then winds slowly down towards Nandrova Falls (2kms) from the camping area. Return back along the main Nandroya Falls track or continue along the full circuit track (7.2km). It

then skirts a steep hillside before rejoining the main track about 1km from the camping area Camping permits can be obtained from the self-registration station at the camping area.

FOR YOUR SAFFTY Babinda Creek has The 'Boulders' 

claimed many lives. KEEP TO WAIKING TRACKS. Only 8 kilometres from the Babinda turnoff beneath the foothills of Bartle

Frere, lie the beautiful Boulders which is the starting point for several , kcellent bushwalks. These include:

Devil's Pool Walk to the Boulders Lookout (100m); Devil's Pool Lookout (470m) and onto Boulders Gorae Lookout (600m).

highest peak. Distance to the Summit is 7.5 kilometres (allow 2 days return). The trail is unformed and very steep in some places Keep to marked trail as it is easy to get lost in dense rainforest. Access to the trail is at the turnoff to Josephine Falls (2 kilometres south of Miriwinni) on the Bruce Highway. The park entrance is 8 kilometres from the turnoff. From the parking area you will make a steep gradual climb coming to Big Rock Camp. You seek local info from Ranger Station; can either climb to Broken Nose or continue, to pass over numerous granite boulders, and on to the Summit. From the Summit, you can return to your starting point or continue on to the Junction camp (15 kilometres total length). Be sure to make private transport arrangements.

At 1622 metres, Bartle Frere is Queensland's The trail to Broken Nose is 10km return (allow 8hrs), is difficult and steep. There is no water along the trail. Offers excellent views of the coast and the Atherton Tableland

> A camping permit is required & available from a self-registration stand at Josephine Falls trail end. Only the fittest bushwalkers can cover this distance in one day so the hike is best undertaken over 2 days. SAFETY FOR HIKERS
